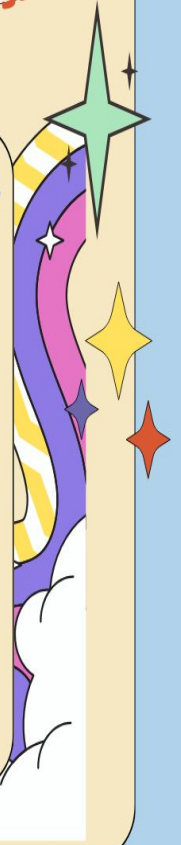


### School's Out

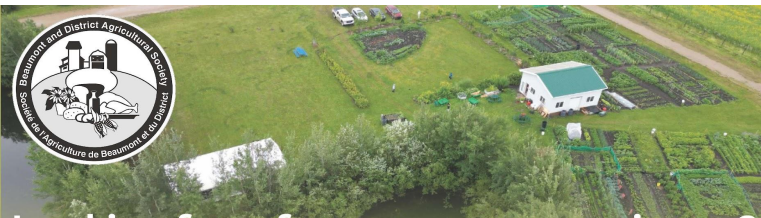
