APPEAL PROCEDURES FOR MARKS, CREDITS, REPORT CARDS

In accordance with [Black Gold Administrative Procedure 390](#), appeals for school-awarded marks can be made for up to 10 business (school) days after the mark was issued on June 28th, 2024. Appeals can be made until noon, July 12, 2024 by contacting Mr. Jon Ganton via email at: jon.ganton@blackgold.ca.

Diploma Exam mark appeals are made via direct contact with Alberta Education on and after July 17, 2020 when marks are made available on myPass. Appeals for diploma exam marks must be made prior to August 6, 2020.

Credit checks for all grade 10 and 11 students will be completed over the summer and will be mailed out to parents at the end of August.

On July 19, 2024, diploma exam marks from June administration will be available on *myPass* on the Alberta Education website.

REGISTRATION OF NEW STUDENTS

All registrations of new students will be processed from August 21-23 after the JMHS office reopens. Confirmation and requests for any additional information needed for new students will be given/requested when registrations are processed.

RETURNING STUDENTS - VERIFICATION FORM

Students who were attending a Black Gold School Division (BGSD) school in 2023-2024 and are returning to a BGSD school in 2024-2025 are automatically registered for the 2024-2025 school year.

Please Note that Pre K students who will be attending Kindergarten are not automatically registered even if they attended a Black Gold school in the previous year. These students will need to register.
All BGSD families are expected to complete the Student Enrollment Verification Form for the 2024-2025 school year. In late August, parents/guardians will receive an email via SchoolMessenger with details on how to access this form during the first week of school.
